## **What is an AED?**

AED stands for Automated External Defibrillator. It is an electronic device that analyzes the heart rhythm of a Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) casualty and administers a shock if needed.

Designed to be easy to operate, AEDs walk users step-by-step through the process of defibrillation. All you need to do is turn on the machine, place the electrode pads on the casualty as directed, and allow the AED to do the rest. The AED analyzes the heart rate and rhythm, and determines whether or not the casualty requires a shock. If needed, you will be prompted to press the shock button and stand back. If a shock is not needed, it will give instructions on how to proceed. There is no risk of delivering an accidental/unnecessary shock to a person who is not in need of one.

Defibrillators do not replace CardioPulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). For best results, get certified in CPR and be prepared to help. Always call 911 for medical emergencies.

## **What is Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA)?**

Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) is the abrupt loss of heart function. The majority of SCA deaths are preceded by a period of *arrhythmia* (erratic electrical impulses causing ineffective heartbeats). The most common types of arrhythmia are Ventricular Fibrillation (V-Fib) and Ventricular Tachycardia (V-Tach). During V-Fib, the heart quivers instead of pumping normally, while during V-Tach, the lower chambers of the heart (ventricles) beat at an abnormally rapid rate, preventing the heart chambers from properly filling with blood. Without help, these arrhythmias will often lead to cardiac arrest and death.

While bystander CardioPulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) can extend the window of survival for a casualty of SCA, the administration of an electrical shock with an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is the definitive method of reversing V-Fib and V-Tach, allowing the heart to resume beating on its own.

## What is AEDGrant.com?

AEDGrant is a corporate buy-down sponsorship funded by generous donations, corporate backing, and AED manufacturer sponsorship.

An approved grant can provide up to \$1,300 toward the purchase price of an AED, depending on model and price range. There are 10-15 different models to choose from in the AEDGrant program. Exact grant amounts are determined after review and approval of your application.

The goal of this program is to get as many AEDs as possible into as many public and private locations as possible. With every minute that goes by, the survival rate of a SCA victim drops by 10%, leaving a small window in which to provide critical emergency care. Even when CPR is properly performed, defibrillation with an AED is necessary to stop the abnormal rhythm and restore a normal heartbeat. Each year, over 350,000 people in the U.S. experience out-of-hospital cardiac arrest (OHCA). 70% to 90% of those individuals die before reaching the hospital. NIH studies show that early CPR and the use of an AED is associated with nearly a doubling of survival rates.

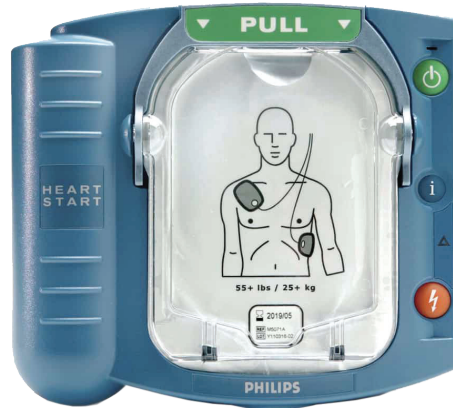
